Why this CoP?

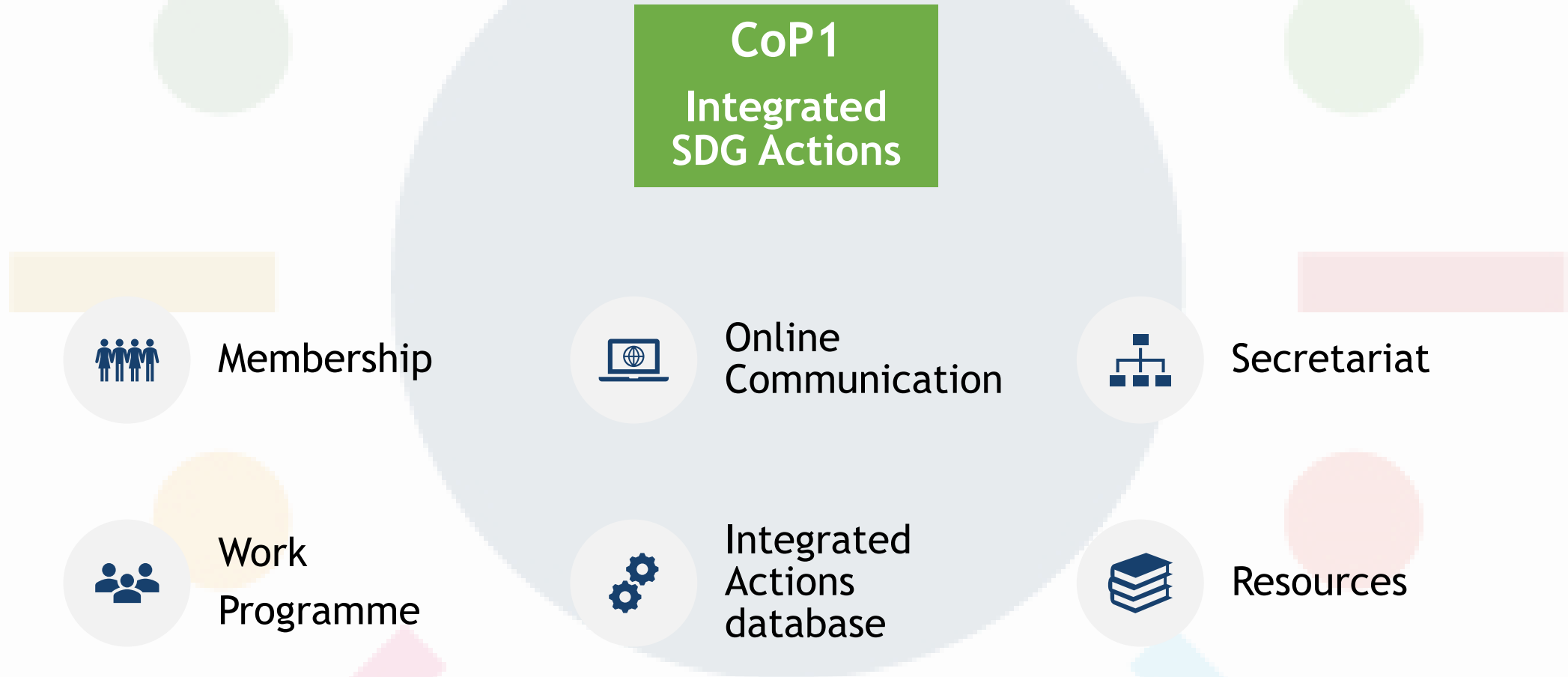
- **Countdown to the SDG Summit webinar series found that**
 - Many individuals/entities working on synergies/trade-offs among SDGs,
 - In different sectors, specialties, levels and contexts,
 - Often in a siloed and partial way despite facing similar challenges.
- **Aim:** To explore, refine, and learn from each, how integrated actions based on cooperation among multiple stakeholders across sectors, specialties, levels can accelerate SDG progress.

What will the CoP do?

- **Share experience, knowledge, and scientific research** relating to integrated approaches to accelerate progress towards the SDGs.
- **Encourage a critical exchange of ideas** on research, in the interest of advancing the understanding and development of integrated policies and practices at all levels.
- **Share good practices in leveraging integrated approaches** amongst members and with a wider audience.
- **Identify areas for cooperation, including joint projects** and partnerships, to address current and emerging challenges raised in the CoP and to inform policy and practice.
- **Share and develop tool kits** to facilitate the implementation of integrated approaches and solutions.

What is the Circle Community?

- Our Circle community is IntegrateSDGs' collaborative workspace to share ideas and resources, collectively solve problems, host events, and engage with other members of the community.

Progress/Next Phase

- **Phase 1 (Scoping):**
 - **Webinar series** that brought together experts to share recommendations on integrated approaches for each SDG.
- **Phase 2 (Capacity Building/Launch)**
 - **Online infrastructure:** website (CoP1 page), communication platform (Circle)
 - **Community-building and awareness raising:**
 - events (HLPF, SoTF), consultation (webinars: experts, MGoS), training (30 Oct. 2023)
 - **Knowledge infrastructure:** database (questionnaire), resources (initial library).
- **Next Phase (Operations/activities)**
 - Workshops to showcase and discuss innovative research and practice (2-3 per year), resulting in new partnerships and publications and dissemination at side events.
 - Advisory board and endorsing partners to help steer activities
